Description of work

Omega was instructed by the school to remove all asbestos materials from their recently purchased property, which was to be developed into a new sixth form centre. This project was scheduled a month before the new school year. Method of work

The works involved removal of AIB ceilings and partition walls to various classrooms together with the removal of thermoplastic floor tiles and adhesive throughout the school building floor areas. Additional works involved removal of soffits and obsolete boilers and heating pipework.
